➤ **Anhydrous Ferric Chloride**

Iron (III) chloride (Ferric Chloride, FeCl_3) has been used in the synthesis of Au/Fe nanoparticles. It has been used as oxidative etching agent during the preparation of platinum nanostructures. Iron (III) chloride, also called ferric chloride, is an industrial scale commodity chemical compound, with the formula FeCl_3 and with iron in the +3 oxidation state.





The colour of iron (III) chloride crystals depends on the viewing angle: by reflected light the crystals appear dark green, but by transmitted light they appear purple-red. Anhydrous iron (III) chloride is deliquescent, forming hydrated hydrogen chloride mists in moist air. It is rarely observed in its natural form, the mineral molysite, known mainly from some fumaroles.

Ferric chloride is a brownish liquid which has a pungent odor which is similar to that of hydrochloric acid. It also exists in solid lump form or in anhydrous powder form. Ferric Chloride or Iron (III) Chloride is used as a flocking agent in drinking water and waste water treatment in various industries. The global ferric chloride market is estimated to witness a CAGR of 4.82% during the forecast period, 2018-2023. Asia-Pacific is expected to account for the major share of the market with the growing stringent regulations in the water treatment industry in the region. By application, water treatment will continue to be the largest end-user of ferric chloride.



Owing to the implementation of various new amendments regarding safe drinking water act, the utilization of ferric chloride has increased in the municipal potable water treatment over the recent past. Moreover, use of ferric chloride for etching of Printed Circuit Boards has increased, this will have a significant impact on the growth of ferric chloride market. Ferric chloride solutions are also being used in surface treatment of metals like copper and zinc for removing scales.

One driver in the market is increase in demand for wastewater reuse. Industries discharge wastewater that contains contaminated inorganic compounds that can have toxic effects on the marine life and cause serious water pollution if released untreated into rivers, ponds, or lakes. Mandatory guidelines by various regulatory bodies including the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) make the treatment and reuse of industrial wastewater compulsory. The use of ferric chloride for the treatment of wastewater is the key reason for its high demand. This is critical in countries where there are scarce resources for drinking water but abundant seawater such as in the Middle East.

➤ **Silver Coated Sugar Balls**

➤ **Silicone Coated Paper**

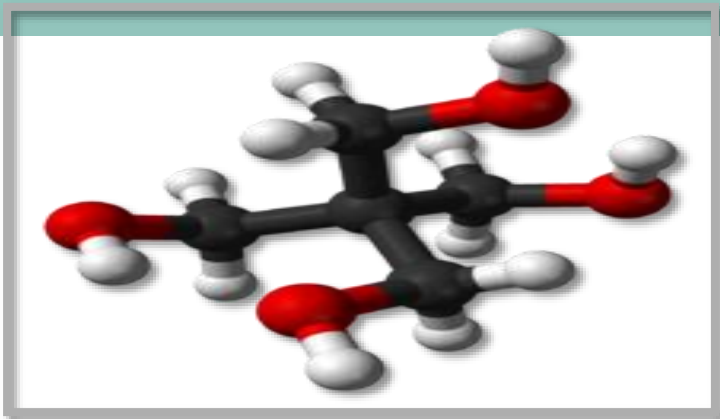

➤ **Pentaerythritol**

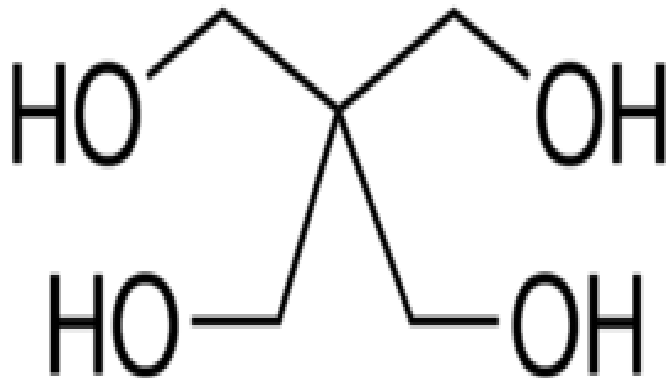
Pentaerythritol is an organic compound with the formula $C(CH_2OH)_4$. Classified as a polyol, it is a white solid. Pentaerythritol is a building block for the synthesis and production of explosives, plastics, paints, appliances, cosmetics, and many other commercial products.

Pentaerythritol was selected as a candidate material in the temperature range below $200^{\circ}C$. It is a material with several interesting features. Its heat of crystalline transition is as large as the heat of fusion of ice and it is not costly, because it is produced on a relatively large scale as a chemical commodity.



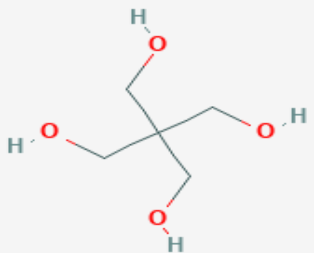
Pentaerythritol or 2, 2-bis (hydroxymethyl) propane-1,3-diol is an odorless white, crystalline, solid organic compound. It is tetrahydric neopentyl alcohol with chemical formula $C_5H_{12}O_4$ and is non-hygroscopic, non-volatile, and stable in air. It is predominantly used in the surface coating industries.

The global pentaerythritol market includes rapid industrialization, increasing automotive production and sales, and rising building & construction activities across the globe. Furthermore, increasing automotive production along with rising application scope such as surface coating and lubricants is estimated to propel the growth of the market.



Pentaerythritol is an alcohol containing four hydroxyl groups obtained from the aldol condensation process of formaldehyde and acetaldehyde. Pentaerythritol is an odorless, light yellow crystalline powder soluble in water. Pentaerythritol has different derivatives such as pentaerythritol esters, pentaerythritol tetranitrate, pentaerythritol tri-acrylate and dipentaerythritol.

The global pentaerythritol market is categorized on the basis of application, and region. On the basis of the application, the market is categorized into paints & coatings, plasticizers, lubricants, adhesive & sealant, inks, varnishes, and others.

Disperse dyes are commonly used to dye in two ways, namely high temperature and pressure method and the hot-melt method. The so-called high temperature and pressure method is actually that the temperature is only 130 °C, and the pressure is only 0.2MPa (gauge pressure).

Disperse dyes are the only water-insoluble dyes that dye polyester and acetate fibers. Disperse dye molecules are the smallest dye molecules among all dyes.





Disperse dyes is a class of non-ionic dye, which has low water solubility and exists in water primarily in a highly dispersed state by means of the effect of the dispersing agent in the process of dyeing. It is mainly used for dyeing polyester fibers. The chemical structure of most disperse dyes belong to monoazo type, which accounts for about 80% of all the disperse dyes.

Disperse dyes are finely ground water-insoluble dyes that are mainly used for dyeing synthetic textiles. The thriving textile industry across the globe and vast technological advances observed in the field of paints and coatings have collectively been boosting the global demand for disperse dyes in the past few years. Disperse dyes can be segmented into three basic types: low energy disperse dyes, medium energy disperse dyes, and high energy disperse dyes. The low energy variety possesses low sublimation fastness, low polarity, low molecular weight, and high dyeing rate.

Disperse dyes are synthetic in nature and are far less water-soluble. Dye material is finely grounded in the form of paste or a powder. Disperse dyes are generally used with dye bath solutions in which dispersing agents are employed to increase the water solubility of the dye.

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➤ Cricket Ball and Bat Manufacturing

Cricket Ball

A cricket ball is a hard, solid ball used to play cricket. In men's cricket the ball must weigh between 5.5 and 5.75 ounces (137.5 and 143.8 g) and measure between 8 13/16 and 9 in (220 and 225 mm) in circumference.

A cricket ball is a hard, solid ball used to play cricket. A cricket ball consists of cork covered by leather, and manufacture is regulated by cricket law at first-class level.





The manipulation of a cricket ball, through employment of its various physical properties, is a staple component of bowling and dismissing batsmen. Movement in the air, and off the ground, is influenced by the condition of the ball.

A cricket ball is made from cork strips and a tightly wound string. It is then covered by a leather case with a slightly protruding seam. The outer layer of a ball, which is covered by the highest quality leather, is cut into four pieces.

Cricket ball industry is on firm footing looking to the internal and increase in export demand, there is a good scope for starting new manufacturing units in different parts of the country. About 90 units at Meerut, Jalandhar and other places are engaged in the manufacturing of cricket balls each employing 10 to 30 workers. The production is about 180 thousand dozens per year valued more than Rupees 300 lakhs.

Cricket Bat

A cricket bat is a specialised piece of equipment used by batsmen in the sport of cricket to hit the ball, typically consisting of a cane handle attached to a flat-fronted willow-wood blade. The length of the bat may be no more than 38 inches (965 mm) and the width no more than 4.25 inches (108 mm).

Cricket bats are the specialized equipment used by the cricket players. Cricket bats may come in different sizes but the length of the cricket bat may be no more than 38 inches and the width no more than 4.25 inches.

Calcium nitrate, also called Norgessalpeter (Norwegian saltpeter), is an inorganic compound with the formula $\text{Ca}(\text{NO}_3)_2$. This colourless salt absorbs moisture from the air and is commonly found as a tetrahydrate. It is mainly used as a component in fertilizers but has other applications. Nitrocalcite is the name for a mineral which is a hydrated calcium nitrate that forms as an efflorescence where manure contacts concrete or limestone in a dry environment as in stables or caverns.





Calcium nitrate is produced by applying nitric acid to limestone and then adding ammonia. It is known as a double salt, since it is comprised of two nutrients common in fertilizers which are high in sodium. The processed result also looks crystallized like salt. Calcium Nitrate is a colorless anhydrous salt that is used as a fertilizer, among other applications.

Calcium nitrate is obtained by treating limestone with weak nitric acid. It is also formed during the absorption of nitrogen oxide by milk of lime. Calcium Nitrate is also used in wastewater treatment, as a component in the manufacture of concrete, for medicinal purposes in cooling baths, and to store energy in solar power plants.

Calcium nitrate is mainly produced as a fertilizer, used for plant nutrition purposes, and for wastewater treatment. It is a source of both calcium and nitrogen, for plants.

Calcium nitrate is actively used to suppress the formation of odor in sewer networks and municipal wastewater treatment. The foul odor emanates primarily due to the release of hydrogen sulfide. Hydrogen sulfide production in sewers is associated with corrosion of concrete and metals, operational problems in wastewater treatment plants (WWTP), as well as with hygiene and odor problems.

Global Calcium Nitrate Market is projected to cross USD 11.0 billion by 2023, at a CAGR of over 5% during the forecast period. Demand for calcium nitrate is largely driven by high consumption of calcium nitrate fertilizers in emerging economies in Asia Pacific and Latin America.



➤ Coconut Plantation

The coconut tree is a member of the palm tree family and the only living species of the genus Cocos. The term "coconut" (or the archaic "cocoanut") can refer to the whole coconut palm, the seed, or the fruit, which botanically is a drupe, not a nut. The term is derived from the 16th-century Portuguese and Spanish word coco meaning "head" or "skull" after the three indentations on the coconut shell that resemble facial features.





The coconut tree starts to bear fruit within six to 10 years of seed germination. The full production age is achieved at 15 to 20 years. A healthy coconut tree continues to produce a full harvest until the age of 80 years, with a count of 50 to 200 fruits per tree over the course of a lifetime.

The coconut palm excels in the tropics, notably the Philippines and Indonesia closely followed by India and Brazil which combined, account for approximately 80% of the world's coconut production. Coconut is grown in over more than 80 countries worldwide, but the truth is the majority of the worlds. Coconut plays a major role in the economy of India. Apart from the importance of copra and coconut oil which is widely used in the manufacture of soaps, hair oil, cosmetics and other industrial products, its husk is a source of fibre which supports a sizable coir industry. The tender nut supplies coconut water, a popular thirst quencher of health and hygienic value which is a multi crore business all over India. Virgin coconut oil (VCO), extracted from fresh coconut kernel without any chemical processes is abundant in vitamins, minerals and anti-oxidants, thus making it the 'mother of all oils.
